### Output Automation from the Command Line

The output format is described with further detail in the **Automation** appendix of the Harmony Manual in the **Interface Automation Commands** section.

You can define the fields to be included in the CSV file for output and the order of appearance of these fields using a string of commands with a space between each command. The first two commands are mandatory and the rest are optional. If no data range is added to a command all data will be included.

A batch file for generating an output file must use the following syntax:

```
HARMONY.EXE /IO /<OutputFileName> [OptionalCommands]
```

Table 1: Output File Commands

/IO	Mandatory parameter for interfaces automatic operation - appear as is with no variable
/N<Interfacename>	Fill-in an interface name (replace the <InterfaceName> with the name of the interface). For example, /NSalary It is recommended that you do not use spaces in the InterfaceName.
/EF	From employee number.
/ET	To employee number.
/GF	From employee group.
/GT	To employee group.
/AF	From work rule.
/AT	To work rule.
/DF	From date DD/MM/YYYY - fixed format.
/DT	To date DD/MM/YYYY - fixed format.
/M	Mail address
/U	Mail server user name.

#### Example 1:

An automatically operated output interface for employees 1-999:

```
Harmony.EXE /IO /NOutput /EF1 /ET999 /DF01/08/2005 /DT31/08/2005
```

In the above example an automatic operation of an output interface for employees 1-999 from August 1st until August 31st was performed.

#### Example 2:

An automatically operated output interface for employees details.  
(interface called emp\_export)

```
Harmony.EXE /IO /Nemp_export
```
